

Genus *Burarchaeum*

Etymology

[Bur.ar.chae'um] **N.L. n.** *burus*, from buru, meaning kangaroo in the Dharawal language; **N.L. neut. n.** *archaeum*, archaeon; **N.L. neut. n.** *Burarchaeum*, an archaeon from the land of the kangaroos

Nomenclatural type

Species *Burarchaeum australiense*^{Ts}

Description

The type species is *Burarchaeum australiense*. The genus appears as g__CABMJK01 in GTDB r202 (Parks et al., 2017).
