

Genus *Bilamarchaeum*

Etymology

[Bi.lam.ar.chae'um] **N.L. n.** *bilama*, freshwater turtle in Dharawal language, in reference to their presence still nowadays in the creeks and rivers associated with the Little Forest Legacy Site; **N.L. neut. n.** *archaeum*, archaeon; **N.L. neut. n.** *Bilamarchaeum*, an archaeon from the turtle lands

Nomenclatural type

Species *Bilamarchaeum dharawalense*^{Ts}

Description

The type species is *Bilamarchaeum dharawalense*. The genus appears as g__CAILMU01 in GTDB r202 (Parks et al., 2017).
