

## Genus *Multiplicimicrobium*

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### Etymology

[Mul.ti.pli.ci.mi.cro'bi.um] L. fem. adj. *multiplex*, manifold; L. neut. n. *microbium*, a microbe; N.L. neut. n. *Multiplicimicrobium*, a microbe from many different environments

### Nomenclatural type

Species *Multiplicimicrobium inquinatum*<sup>Ts</sup>

### Description

This genus belongs to the family *Aquicolibacteriaceae*, order *Omnitrophales*, class *Omnitrophia*, phylum *Omnitrophota*. Assemblies assigned to this genus were recovered from samples of groundwater and engineered environments. The nomenclatural type for the genus is the species *Multiplicimicrobium inquinatum*.
