

Family *Danuiimicrobiaceae*

Etymology

[Da.nu.i.i.mi.cro.bi.a'ce.ae] N.L. neut. n. *Danuiimicrobium*, referring to the type genus *Danuiimicrobium*; *-aceae*, ending to denote a family; N.L. fem. pl. n. *Danuiimicrobiaceae*, the *Danuiimicrobium* family

Nomenclatural type

Genus *Danuiimicrobium*

Description

This family belongs to the order *Omnitrophales*, class *Omnitrophia*, phylum *Omnitrophota*. As a monotypic family, the description of the family is currently the same as for the genus *Danuiimicrobium*, the nomenclatural type for the family.
