

## Genus *Makaraimicrobium*

---

### Etymology

[Ma.ka.ra.i.mi.cro'bi.um] **N.L. n.** *Makara*, a mystical creature of the waters in Hindu mythology; **L. neut. n.** *microbium*, a microbe; **N.L. neut. n.** *Makaraimicrobium*, a microbe named for Makara

### Nomenclatural type

Species *Makaraimicrobium thalassicum*<sup>TS</sup>

### Description

This genus belongs to the family *Tantalellaceae*, order *Tantalellales*, class *Gorgyraia*, phylum *Omnitrophota*. All known assemblies originate from water. The nomenclatural type for the genus is the species *Makaraimicrobium thalassicum*.
