### Etymology

[Ve.le.si.i.mo'nas] **N.L. n.** *Veles*, the Slavic god of earth, waters and the underworld; **L. fem. n.** *monas*, a monad; **N.L. fem. n.** *Velesiimonas*, a monad named for Veles, the Slavic god of earth, waters and the underworld

### Nomenclatural type

Species *Velesiimonas alkalicola*<sup>Ts</sup>

### Description

This monotypic genus belongs to the family *Velesiimonadaceae*, and currently has the same description as its nomenclatural type, the species *Velesiimonas alkalicola*.
