

## Genus *Undivivens*

### Etymology

[Un.di.vi'vens] L. fem. n. *unda*, water; L. pres. part. *vivens*, living; N.L. masc. n. *Undivivens*, living in water

### Nomenclatural type

Species *Undivivens industriae*<sup>T5</sup>

### Description

This genus belongs to the family *Profunditerraquicolaceae*, order *Gygaellales*, class *Velamenicoccia*, phylum *Omnitrophota*. Assemblies for the genus originate from industrial wastewater and soil. The nomenclatural type for the genus is *Undivivens industriae*.
