

## Species *Humimonas hydrogenitrophica*<sup>Ts</sup>

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### Etymology

[hy.dro.ge.ni.tro.phi'ca] N.L. neut. n. *hydrogenum*, hydrogen; Gr. masc. adj. *trophikos*, nursing, tending or feeding; N.L. fem. adj. *hydrogenitrophica*, feeding on hydrogen, referring to the ability of the micro-organism to grow with H<sub>2</sub>/CO<sub>2</sub> as energy source
