### Etymology

[fi.li.a.ven'ti] L. n. fem. *filiae*, daughter; L. n. *ventum*, wind; N.L. n. fem. *filiaventi*, daughter of the wind

### Description

R50 is isolated from the geothermal soils of the island of Pantelleria. The name of the island originates from Arab name Bint al-Riyāh, which means “daughter of the winds.”
