[Pe.le.ar.chae'um] N.L. fem. n. *Pele*, Name of the goddess of volcanoes and fire in Hawaiian mythology; N.L. neut. n. *archaeum*, An archaeon; N.L. neut. n. *Pelearchaeum*, An archaeon named after Pele, the goddess of volcanoes and fire
