
Genus *Azobacteroides*

Etymology

[A.zo.bac.ter.oi'des] **N.L. pref.** *azo-*, pertaining to nitrogen (from N.L. neut. n. *azotum*; from French masc. n. *azote*; from Gr. pref. *a-*, not; from Gr. fem. n. *zôê*, life; from N.Gr. fem. n. *azôê*, not sustaining life); **N.L. masc. n.** *Bacteroides*, a bacterial genus name; **N.L. masc. n.** *Azobacteroides*, a nitrogen (fixing) *Bacteroides*
