

## Family *Methanoliparaceae*

### Etymology

[Me.tha.no.li.pa.ra.ce'ae] N.L. neut. n. *Methanoliparum*, referring to the type genus *Methanoliparum*; -aceae, ending to denote a family; N.L. fem. pl. n. *Methanoliparaceae*, the *Methanoliparum* family

### Nomenclatural type

Genus *Methanoliparum*

### Description

Analyses of enrichment cultures indicate that members of this family can utilize long-chain alkanes as substrate for methanogenesis.
