

## Species *Rhodopirellula halodulae*

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### Etymology

[ha.lo.du'lae] N.L. gen. n. *halodulae*, of Halodule, a seagrass genus from which the new strain was isolated

### Nomenclatural type

### Description

Pink pigmented, oval to pear-shaped cells, form aggregates and divides by budding. Aerobic, marine, and mesophilic with optimum temperature for growth is 25 degrees Celsius, and grows in pH range of 6-10 (optimum pH 7.0). The type strain is JC737 isolated from the surface of a seagrass Halodule sp. from Tamil Nadu India. The genome of the type strain is deposited with accession number JAKFV000000000 (GCA\_020966775.1).
