Etymology

[fi.mi.pul.lo'rum] L. neut. n. *fimus*, dung, excrement; L. masc. n. *pullus*, chicken; N.L. gen. pl. masc. n. *fimipullorum*, of chicken dung; denoting the putative origin from chicken manure

Nomenclatural type

Description

The species identified by metagenomic analyses. The G+C content of the type genome is 42.9%, and the estimated genome size is 1.93 Mbp.
