### Etymology

[Se.ge.ti.mi.cro'bi.um.] L. gen. n. *segetis*, of the soil; N.L. neut. n. *microbium*, microbe; N.L. neut. n. *Segetimicrobium*, a microbe of the earth

### Nomenclatural type

Species *Segetimicrobium genomatis*<sup>Ts</sup>

### Description

A genus established on the basis of AAI, ANI, dDDH and phylogenomic analyses, and is classified as a member of the *Segetimicrobiaceae* family. The type species of the genus is *Segetimicrobium genomatis*.
