

## Genus *Kaftiobacterium*

### Etymology

[Kaf.ti.o.bac.te.ri.um] Gr. adj. *kafti*, hot; N.L. neut. n. *bacterium*, rod or staff and, in biology a bacterium; N.L. neut. n. *Kaftiobacterium*, a bacterium in hot environment

### Nomenclatural type

Species *Kaftiobacterium secundum*<sup>Ts</sup>

### Description

A genus established on the basis of AAI, ANI, dDDH and phylogenomic analyses, and is classified as a member of the *Kaftiobacteriaceae* family. The type species of the genus is *Kaftiobacterium primum*.
