

Genus *Fervidifonticulor*

Etymology

[Fer.vi.di.fon.ti.cul'tor] L. masc. adj. *fervidus*, hot, burning; L. masc. n. *fons*, a spring, fountain; L. masc. n. *cultor*, an inhabitant; N.L. masc. n. *Fervidifonticulor*, inhabitant of a hot spring

Nomenclatural type

Species *Fervidifonticulor primus*^{Ts}

Description

A genus established on the basis of AAI, ANI, dDDH and phylogenomic analyses, and is classified as a member of the *Humiculatoraceae* family. The type species of the genus is *Fervidifonticulor primus*.
