

Genus *Xiheicaenibacterium*

Etymology

[Xi.he.i.cae'ni.bac.te'ri.um] **N.L. fem. n.** *Xihe*, Sun goddess in Chinese mythology; **L. neut. n.** *caenum*, mud, sludge; **L. neut. n.** *bacterium*, a bacterium; **N.L. neut. n.** *Xiheicaenibacterium*, a microbe found in sludge environments associated with phototrophy

Species *Xiheicaenibacterium phototrophicum*^{Ts}

The type species is *Xiheicaenibacterium phototrophicum*.
