

## Genus *Villigracilis*

### Etymology

[Vi.ll.i.gra.ci'lis] L. **masc.** n. *villus*, tuft of hair; L. **masc. adj.** *gracilis*, slim, slender; N.L. **masc. n.** *Villigracilis*, bacteria shaped as a slender tuft of hair

### Nomenclatural type

Species *Villigracilis saccharophilus*<sup>Ts</sup>

### Description

A genus established on the basis of MiGA taxonomic novelty analyses, ANI, 16S rRNA gene phylogenetic reconstruction, FISH and phylogenomic analyses and is classified as a member of the Villigracilaceae. The type species of the genus is *Villigracilis saccarophilus*.
