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### Etymology

[ho'e.ni.ri'i] **N.L. gen. n.** *hoenirii*, hoenirii of Hoenir, Norse god of silence

### Description

The MAG representative for this species was isolated from activated sludge, wastewater treatment plant located in Aalborg West, Denmark. Based on metabolic annotation, the species show similar metabolic potential to its close relatives *Phosphoribacter baldrii* and *hodrii*
