

Species *Aelusimicrobium pullicaecorum*

Etymology

[pul.li.cae.co'rum] **L. masc. n.** *pullus*, a chicken; **N.L. neut. n.** *caecum*, caecum; **N.L. gen. pl. n.** *pullicaecorum*, of the caeca of chickens, referring to the isolation source

Nomenclatural type

Description

The species comprises only metagenome-assembled genomes. The species includes all bacteria with more than 95% average nucleotide identity (ANI) to the type genome. The GC content of the type genome is 52% and the estimated genome size is 1.6 Mbp.
