

Family *Phycocordibacteraceae*

Etymology

[Phy.co.cor.di.bac.ter.a'ce.ae] **L. masc. n.** *Phycocordibacter*, referring to the type genus *Phycocordibacter*; *-aceae*, ending to denote a family; **N.L. fem. pl. n.** *Phycocordibacteraceae*, the *Phycocordibacter* family

Nomenclatural type

Genus *Phycocordibacter*

Description

This is a family within the Patescibacteria phylum, some of whose members are symbionts of the microalgae *Nannochloropsis oceanica* strain IMET1 and *Tetrademus obliquus* strain HTB1. Both microalgae are grown with 10% CO₂ for carbon mitigation research.
