

## Family *Dormimicrobiaceae*

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### Etymology

[Dor.mi.mi.cro.bi.a'ce.ae] **N.L. neut. n.** *Dormimicrobium*, a dormant microbe; *-aceae*, ending to denote a family; **N.L. fem. pl. n.** *Dormimicrobiaceae*, the Dormimicrobium family

### Nomenclatural type

Genus *Dormimicrobium*

### Description

The taxon is equivalent to placeholder family f\_JACDCP01 under the GTDB R220.
