[gle.bi'cum] **L. fem. n.** *gleba*, clod or lump of earth; **L. neut. adj. suff.** *-icum*, suffix used with the sense of belonging to; **N.L. neut. adj.** *glebicum*, Pertinent to lumps of earth, referring to a species found in soil
