Etymology

[E.da.pho.mi.cro.bi.a'ce.ae] **N.L. neut. n.** *Edaphomicrobium*, the type genus of the family; **L. fem. pl. suff.** *-aceae*, ending to denote a family; **N.L. fem. pl. n.** *Edaphomicrobiaceae*, family of the genus *Edaphomicrobium*

Nomenclatural type

Genus *Edaphomicrobium*

Description

Family formerly known as "[CSP1-4](#)" in GTDB R226. The description of the family is the same as for its type genus *Edaphomicrobium*.
