

Species *Diernaesiella sediminis*

Etymology

[se.di.mi'nis] **L. fem. gen. n. *sediminis***, A species found in sediments

Nomenclatural type

Description

Species established on the basis of ANI comparisons to GTDB R226 and 16S rRNA classifications to Silva 138.2. Based on metabolic reconstruction, *Diernaesiella sediminis* is inferred to encode the rod shape-determining protein MreB and peptidoglycan biosynthesis genes.
