

Species *Volstedibacter aridus*

Etymology

[a'ri.dus] **L. masc. adj.** *aridus*, Dry, referring to a species found in arid soil

Nomenclatural type

Description

Species established on the basis of ANI comparisons to GTDB R226 and 16S rRNA classifications to Silva 138.2. Formerly "uncultured Acidobacteria bacterium" in Silva 138.2. Based on metabolic reconstruction, *Volstedibacter aridus* is inferred to encode the rod shape-determining protein MreB and peptidoglycan biosynthesis genes.
