

## Species *Oedumimorpha septentrionalis*<sup>Ts</sup>

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### Etymology

[sep.ten.tri.o.na'lis] **L. fem. adj.** *septentrionalis*, A species found in the north (northern Europe)

### Nomenclatural type

### Description

Species established on the basis of ANI comparisons to GTDB R226 and 16S rRNA classifications to Silva 138.2. Based on metabolic reconstruction, *Oedumimorpha septentrionalis* is inferred to encode peptidoglycan biosynthesis genes.
