
Species *Strynoemicrobium terreum*^{Ts}

Etymology

[ter're.um] **L. neut. adj.** *terreum*, A species found in soil

Description

Species established on the basis of ANI comparisons to GTDB R226 and 16S rRNA classifications to Silva 138.2. Formerly "uncultured Chitinophagaceae bacterium" in Silva 138.2. Based on metabolic reconstruction, *Strynoemicrobium terreum* is inferred to encode the rod shape-determining protein MreB and peptidoglycan biosynthesis genes.
