

Species *Oesbybacterium septentrionale*

Etymology

[sep.ten.tri.o.na'le] **L. neut. adj.** *septentrionale*, A species found in the north (northern Europe)

Nomenclatural type

Description

Species established on the basis of ANI comparisons to GTDB R226 and 16S rRNA classifications to Silva 138.2. Formerly "uncultured bacterium" in Silva 138.2. Based on metabolic reconstruction, *Oesbybacterium septentrionale* is inferred to encode the rod shape-determining protein MreB and peptidoglycan biosynthesis genes.
