

Species *Themius glebicus*

Etymology

[gle.bi'cus] **L. fem. n.** *gleba*, clod or lump of earth; **L. masc. adj. suff.** *-icus*, suffix used with the sense of belonging to; **N.L. masc. adj.** *glebicus*, Pertinent to lumps of earth, referring to a species found in soil

Nomenclatural type

Description

Species established on the basis of ANI comparisons to GTDB R226 and 16S rRNA classifications to Silva 138.2. Formerly "uncultured Conexibacteraceae bacterium" in Silva 138.2. Based on metabolic reconstruction, *Themius glebicus* is inferred to encode the rod shape-determining protein MreB and peptidoglycan biosynthesis genes.
