

Genus *Hygumiana*

Etymology

[hy.gu.mi.a'na] **Danish n.** *Hygum*, Danish parish; **N.L. fem. n.** *Hygumiana*, Microbe named after the Danish parish of Hygum, near which the genome of the type species was recovered.

Nomenclatural type

Species *Hygumiana borealis*^{Ts}

Description

Genus established on the basis of phylogenomic comparisons to GTDB R226 and 16S rRNA classifications to Silva 138.2. Formerly known as genus SZUA-22 in GTDB R226. The description of the genus is the same as for its type species *Hygumiana borealis*.
