

Species *Sebberium ripicum*^{Ts}

Etymology

[ri.pi'cum] **L. fem. n.** *ripa*, seashore; **L. neut. adj. suff.** *-icum*, suffix used with the sense of belonging to; **N.L. neut. adj.** *ripicum*, Pertinent to the seashore, referring to a species found in the coast

Nomenclatural type

Description

Species established on the basis of ANI comparisons to GTDB R226 and 16S rRNA classifications to Silva 138.2. Based on metabolic reconstruction, *Sebberium ripicum* is inferred to encode peptidoglycan biosynthesis genes and flagellar genes.
