

## Genus *Ugevita*

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### Etymology

[u.ge.vi'ta] **Danish n.** *Uge*, Danish parish; **L. fem. n.** *vita*, life; **N.L. fem. n.** *Ugevita*, Microbe named after the Danish parish of Uge, near which the genome of the type species was recovered.

### Nomenclatural type

Species *Ugevita terrea*<sup>Ts</sup>

### Description

Genus established on the basis of phylogenomic comparisons to GTDB R226 and 16S rRNA classifications to Silva 138.2. Formerly known as genus Fen-1038 in GTDB R226. The description of the genus is the same as for its type species *Ugevita terrea*.
