

Genus *Hjerndrupiaba*

Etymology

[hjern.dru.pi.a'ba] **Danish n.** *Hjerndrup*, Danish parish; **N.L. fem. n.** *Hjerndrupiaba*, Microbe arbitrarily named after the Danish parish of Hjerndrup, near which the genome of the type species was recovered.

Nomenclatural type

Species *Hjerndrupiaba contigua*^{Ts}

Description

Genus established on the basis of phylogenomic comparisons to GTDB R226 and 16S rRNA classifications to Silva 138.2. Formerly known as genus Fen-1359 in GTDB R226. The description of the genus is the same as for its type species *Hjerndrupiaba contigua*.

Bacteria » *Planctomycetota* » *Phycisphaerae* » *Sedimentisphaerales* » “*Anaerobacaceae*” » *Hjerndrupiaba*
