

Genus *Rimsoesoma*

Etymology

[rim.soe.so'ma] **Danish n.** *Rimsoe*, Danish parish; **Gr. neut. n.** *soma*, a body; **N.L. neut. n.** *Rimsoesoma*, Microbe named after the Danish parish of Rimsoe, near which the genome of the type species was recovered.

Nomenclatural type

Species *Rimsoesoma aridum*^{Ts}

Description

Genus established on the basis of phylogenomic comparisons to GTDB R226 and 16S rRNA classifications to Silva 138.2. Formerly known as genus JTS-RE37 in GTDB R226. The description of the genus is the same as for its type species *Rimsoesoma aridum*.
