

Species *Ringivemicrobium aridum*^{Ts}

Etymology

[a'ri.dum] **L. neut. adj.** *aridum*, Dry, referring to a species found in arid soil

Nomenclatural type

Description

Species established on the basis of ANI comparisons to GTDB R226 and 16S rRNA classifications to Silva 138.2. Based on metabolic reconstruction, *Ringivemicrobium aridum* is inferred to encode peptidoglycan biosynthesis genes.
