

Genus *Ringivemicrobium*

Etymology

[rin.gi.ve.mi.cro'bi.um] **Danish n.** *Ringive*, Danish parish; **N.L. neut. n.** *microbium*, a microbe; **N.L. neut. n.** *Ringivemicrobium*, Microbe named after the Danish parish of Ringive, near which the genome of the type species was recovered.

Nomenclatural type

Species *Ringivemicrobium aridum*^{Ts}

Description

Genus established on the basis of phylogenomic comparisons to GTDB R226 and 16S rRNA classifications to Silva 138.2. Formerly known as genus CF-96 in GTDB R226. The description of the genus is the same as for its type species *Ringivemicrobium aridum*.
