

Species *Husbymorpha terrea*

Etymology

[ter're.a] **L. fem. adj.** *terrea*, Pertinent to soil, referring to a species found in soil

Nomenclatural type

Description

Species established on the basis of ANI comparisons to GTDB R226 and 16S rRNA classifications to Silva 138.2. Formerly "uncultured bacterium" in Silva 138.2. Based on metabolic reconstruction, *Husbymorpha terrea* is inferred to encode the rod shape-determining protein MreB, peptidoglycan biosynthesis genes and flagellar genes.
