

Species *Hennevivens ripicus*

Etymology

[ri.pi'cus] **L. fem. n.** *ripa*, seashore; **L. masc. adj. suff.** *-icus*, suffix used with the sense of belonging to; **N.L. masc. adj.** *ripicus*, Pertinent to the seashore, referring to a species found in the coast

Nomenclatural type

Description

Species established on the basis of ANI comparisons to GTDB R226 and 16S rRNA classifications to Silva 138.2. Based on metabolic reconstruction, *Hennevivens ripicus* is inferred to encode the rod shape-determining protein MreB and peptidoglycan biosynthesis genes.
