

Species *Kaerumiaba septentrionalis*

Etymology

[sep.ten.tri.o.na'lis] **L. fem. adj.** *septentrionalis*, A species found in the north (northern Europe)

Nomenclatural type

Description

Species established on the basis of ANI comparisons to GTDB R226 and 16S rRNA classifications to Silva 138.2. Formerly "metagenome" in Silva 138.2. Based on metabolic reconstruction, *Kaerumiaba septentrionalis* is inferred to encode peptidoglycan biosynthesis genes.
