

Species *Maglebybacterium aridum*

Etymology

[a'ri.dum] L. neut. adj. *aridum*, Dry, referring to a species found in arid soil

Nomenclatural type

Description

Species established on the basis of ANI comparisons to GTDB R226 and 16S rRNA classifications to Silva 138.2. Formerly "uncultured actinobacterium" in Silva 138.2. Based on metabolic reconstruction, *Maglebybacterium aridum* is inferred to encode peptidoglycan biosynthesis genes.
