

## Species *Gammelstrupium septentrionale*<sup>Ts</sup>

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### Etymology

[sep.ten.tri.o.na'le] **L. neut. adj.** *septentrionale*, A species found in the north (northern Europe)

### Nomenclatural type

### Description

Species established on the basis of ANI comparisons to GTDB R226 and 16S rRNA classifications to Silva 138.2. Based on metabolic reconstruction, *Gammelstrupium septentrionale* is inferred to encode the rod shape-determining protein MreB and peptidoglycan biosynthesis genes.
