

Species *Faaborgimorpha humica*^{Ts}

Etymology

[hu'mi.ca] **N.L. fem. adj.** *humica*, Pertinent to soil, referring to a species found in soil

Nomenclatural type

Description

Species established on the basis of ANI comparisons to GTDB R226 and 16S rRNA classifications to Silva 138.2. Formerly "uncultured Actinomycetales bacterium" in Silva 138.2. Based on metabolic reconstruction, *Faaborgimorpha humica* is inferred to encode the rod shape-determining protein MreB and peptidoglycan biosynthesis genes.
