

Species *Virumibacter telluricus*^{Ts}

Etymology

[te.l.lu.ri'cus] **L. gen. fem. n.** *telluris*, soil or earth; **L. masc. adj. suff.** *-icus*, suffix used with the sense of belonging to; **L. masc. adj.** *telluricus*, Pertinent to soil, referring to a species found in soil

Nomenclatural type

Description

Species established on the basis of ANI comparisons to GTDB R226 and 16S rRNA classifications to Silva 138.2. Based on metabolic reconstruction, *Virumibacter telluricus* is inferred to encode the rod shape-determining protein MreB and peptidoglycan biosynthesis genes.
