

Species *Reseniella sediminis*^{Ts}

Etymology

[se.di.mi'nis] **L. fem. gen. n.** *sediminis*, A species found in sediments

Nomenclatural type

Description

Species established on the basis of ANI comparisons to GTDB R226 and 16S rRNA classifications to Silva 138.2. Formerly "uncultured bacterium" in Silva 138.2. Based on metabolic reconstruction, *Reseniella sediminis* is inferred to encode peptidoglycan biosynthesis genes.
