

Genus *Allohaderslevella*

Etymology

[Al.lo.ha.der.sle.vel'la] **Gr. masc. pron.** *allos*, another, other, different; **Danish n.** *Haderslev*, Danish city; **N.L. fem. n.** *Allohaderslevella*, Microbe named after the Danish city of Haderslev, near which the genome of the type species was recovered

Nomenclatural type

Species *Allohaderslevella sediminis*^{TS}

Description

Genus established on the basis of phylogenomic comparisons to GTDB R226 and 16S rRNA classifications to Silva 138.2. Formerly known as genus RBG-13-51-18 in GTDB R226. The description of the genus is the same as for its type species *Allohaderslevella sediminis*.
