

Species *Binderupivita danica*^{Ts}

Etymology

[da'ni.ca] **L. fem. adj.** *danica*, Danish, referring to a species found in Denmark

Nomenclatural type

Description

Species established on the basis of ANI comparisons to GTDB R226 and 16S rRNA classifications to Silva 138.2. Based on metabolic reconstruction, *Binderupivita danica* is inferred to encode peptidoglycan biosynthesis genes.
