

Species *Hoddevivens nordicus*^{Ts}

Etymology

[nor'di.cus] **L. masc. adj.** *nordicus*, Northern, referring to a species found in the Nordic region (northern Europe)

Nomenclatural type

Description

Species established on the basis of ANI comparisons to GTDB R226 and 16S rRNA classifications to Silva 138.2. Formerly "uncultured bacterium" in Silva 138.2. Based on metabolic reconstruction, *Hoddevivens nordicus* is inferred to encode the rod shape-determining protein MreB and peptidoglycan biosynthesis genes.
