

Species *Oesbyana adiacens*

Etymology

[ad.ia'cens] **L. fem. part. adj.** *adiacens*, Next to, referring to a species related to but distinct from the existing species

Nomenclatural type

Description

Species established on the basis of ANI comparisons to GTDB R226 and 16S rRNA classifications to Silva 138.2. Formerly "uncultured candidate division OS-K bacterium" in Silva 138.2. Based on metabolic reconstruction, *Oesbyana adiacens* is inferred to encode the rod shape-determining protein MreB and peptidoglycan biosynthesis genes.
